#### **Aker Brygge, Oslo**

Residential property, shopping, offices, food outlets and entertainment. Today, Aker Brygge is a vital, pulsating part of Oslo's harbour promenade, with 12 million visitors annually. An important goal of the project was to clear, activate and create diversity. The architect firm chose Bloc from Vestre in order to realise this vision. In the heart of the Dansaert district is the Place du Jardin aux Fleurs: people meet on the square in Dansaert when they are walking the dog in the morning, during their lunch break or in the evening after an art preview or visit to the cinema. The designer Julien De Smedt wished to incorporate the idea of using stairs as a sitting object in his design: he chose Stoop, a public and social bench suited to the requirements of urban life.
