5 products worth checking out

Stoop: your stage and your tribune in one single product.

Stoop is an informal, social meeting place based on the universal idea of using steps as places to sit. This concept enables the creation of an urban auditorium by using several benches, with each bench being able to accommodate up to 9 people. Choose between sitting surfaces made from wooden slats or recycled rubber.

Stripes: an inclusive platform for social gatherings in public spaces.

The starting point for Stripes was the idea of creating large, solid seats in the urban environment, a bit like ottomans or rafts. The range has turned into a modular system consisting of two primary modules, a rectangle and a semicircle, which can be combined to create benches in all different shapes and sizes. Stripes modules can be positioned singly or joined together and, where relevant, integrated with an existing or new tree, acting as a tree guard. The modules have free-standing feet, so they are raised off the ground slightly.



**April Go: sturdy and reliable benches, chairs and tables which have mobility and lightness.

April Go is designed for the changing urban space. These sturdy pieces of furniture are easy to stack and move as required. The steel details are hot-dip galvanised and designed for long-term use. The wood is pine treated with linseed oil. The folding table is available in different wood on request.

**Edo: a new bench from Vestres made completely in solid wood.

The Edo bench represents a material sensibility found in the Nordic countries. Edo is inspired by Scandinavian design and Japanese traditions. A bench for both indoor and outdoor environments, Edo is equally beautiful in high quality ash, oak or pine.

**Bloc Sunbench: living outdoors means taking advantage of the full spectrum of climate.

The BLOC sunbench has the same diagonal fold that is the instantly recognisable feature of the entire BLOC range of furniture. The sunbench is free-standing and can stand alone or be joined in rows, with the foot end/seat in varying lengths.

For all Vestre products, the steel details are hot-dip galvanised and designed for long-term use with a lifetime guarantee against rust. Choose from nearly 200 different RAL colours for powder coating. Many products are also available in stainless steel and corten steel. Products with wood come with linseed-oil-impregnated PEFC-certified high-quality pine from Scandinavia. Other types of wood are available on request.
